3. These labs are also utilized for students to perform their practical and projects.









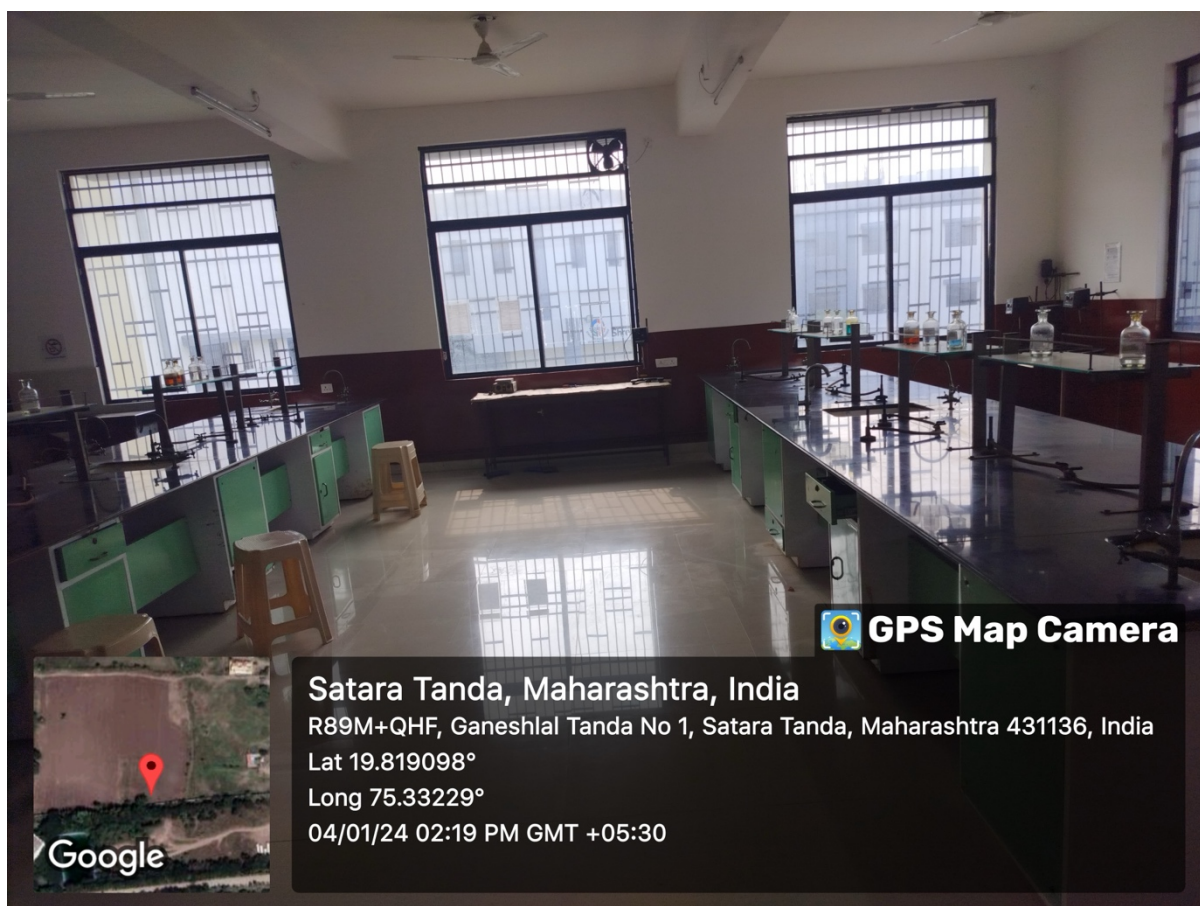




Figure 3 Pharmacchemistry Lab (II Floor)







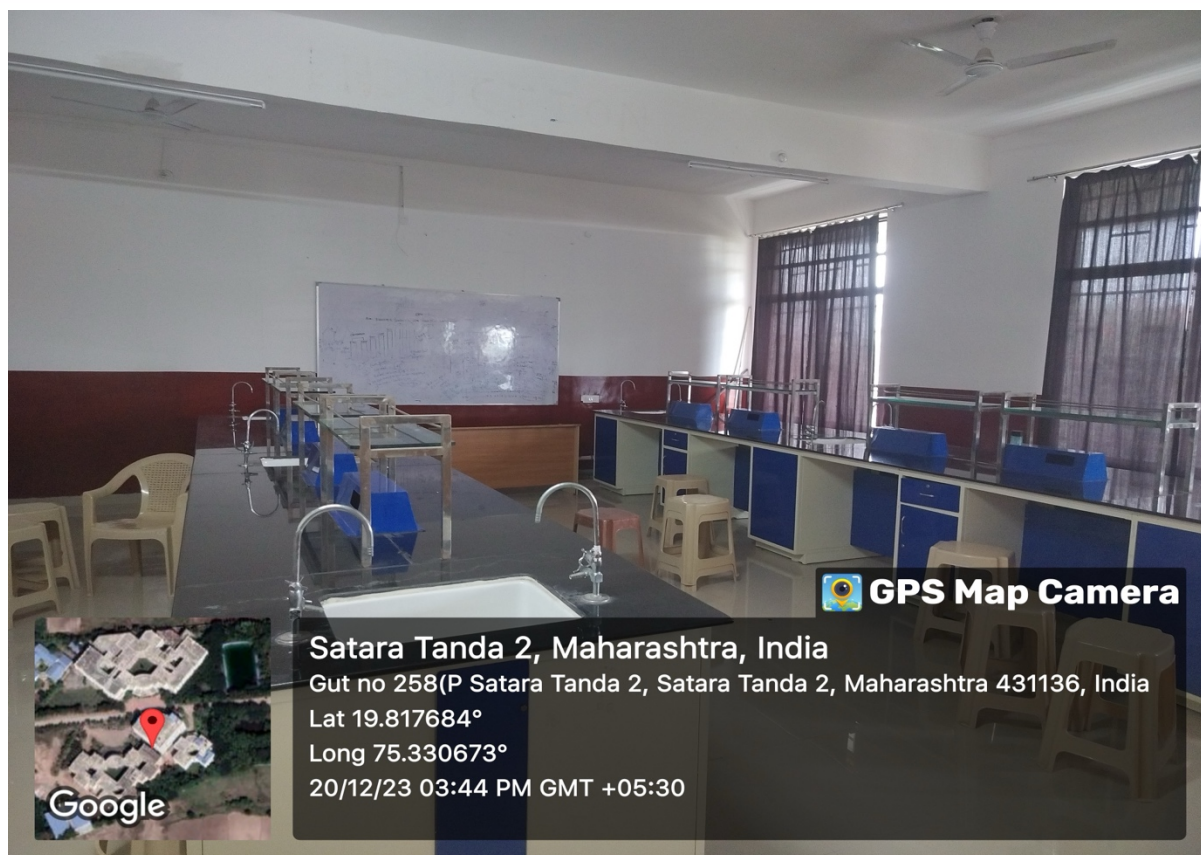




Figure 4 Pharmacology Lab (II floor)

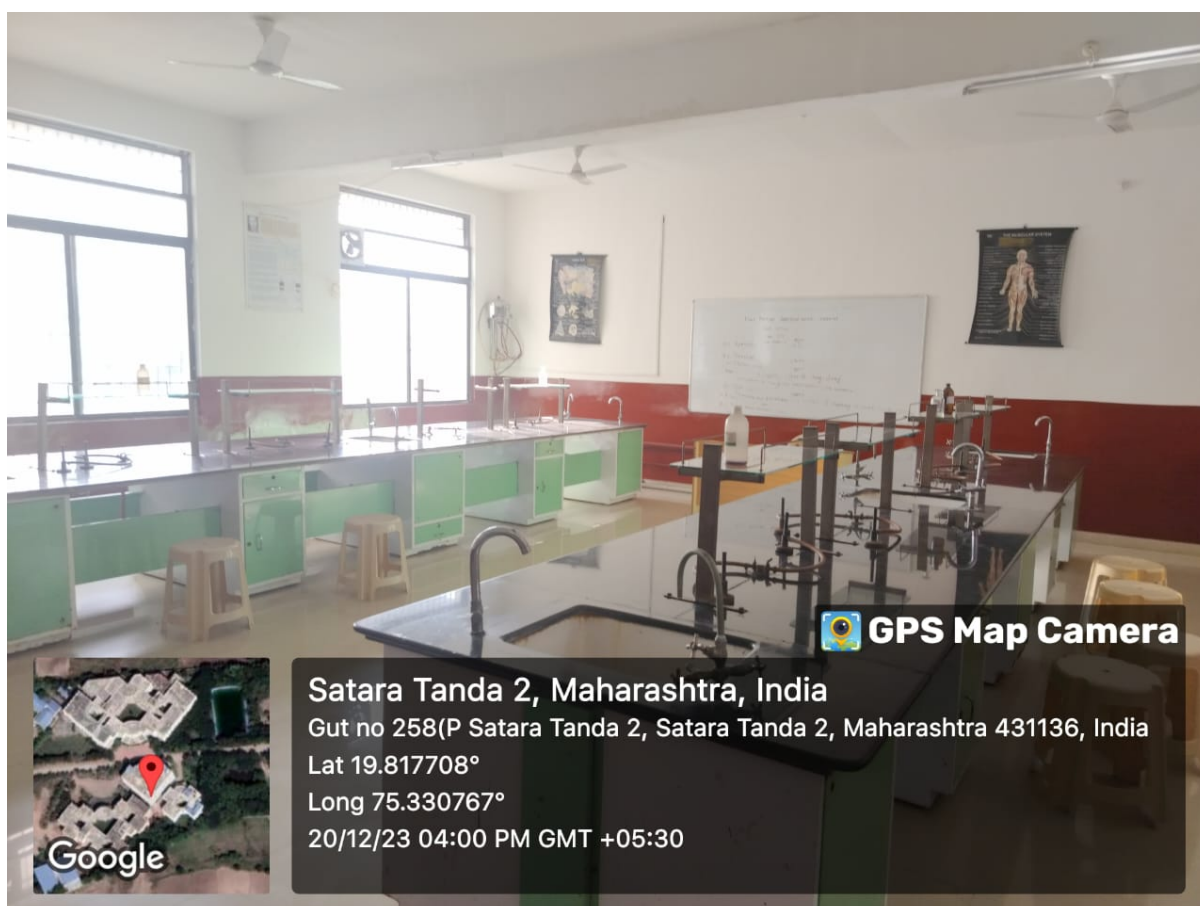
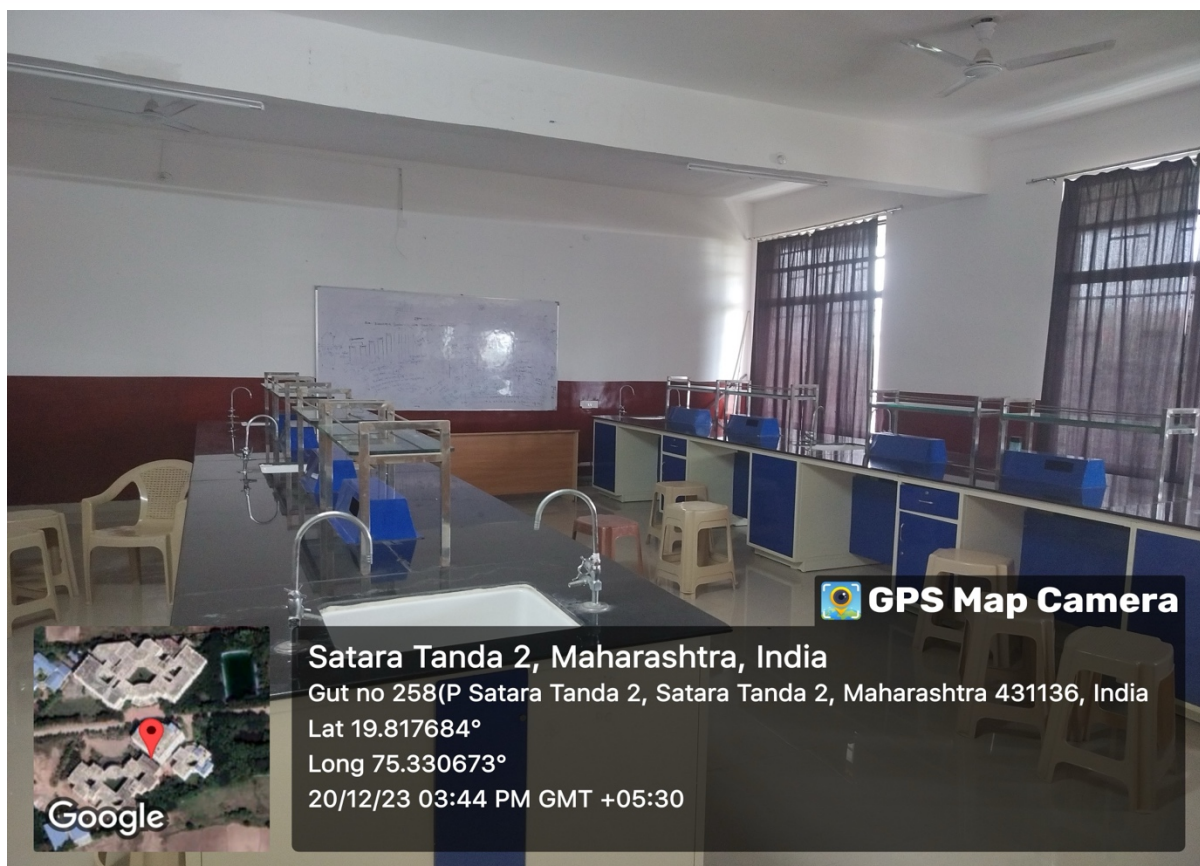

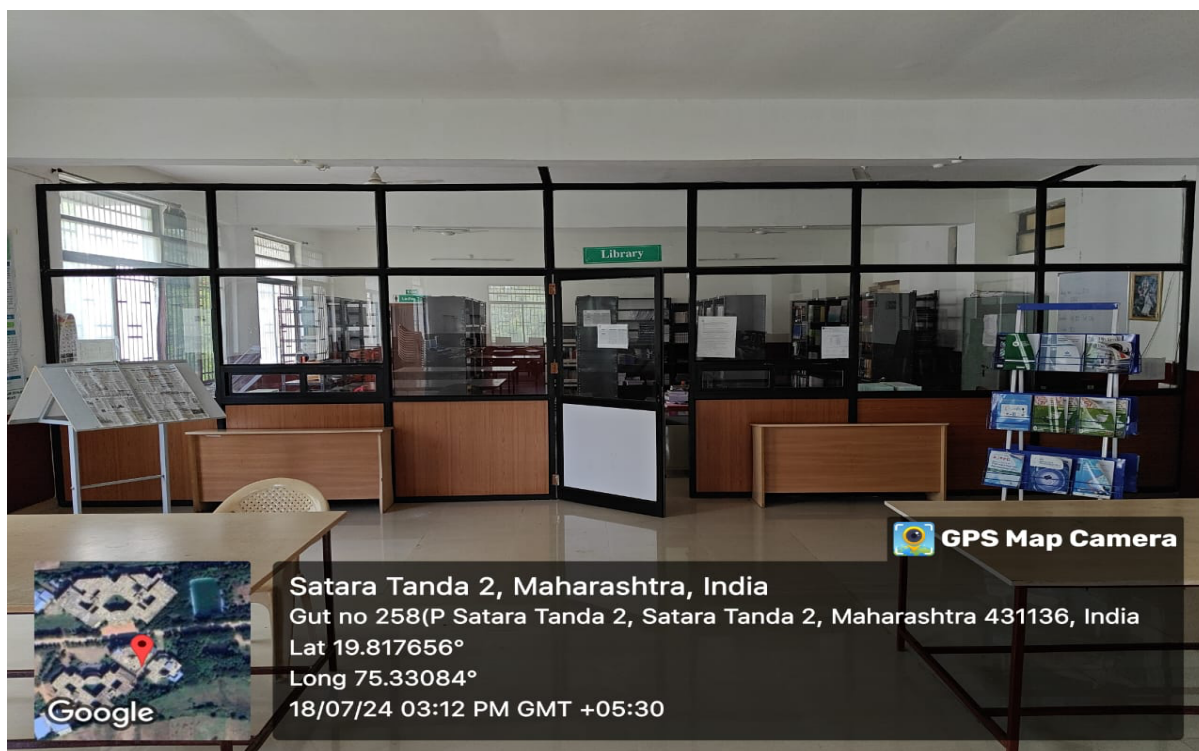


*Figure 14 Music room is located at Underground floor*

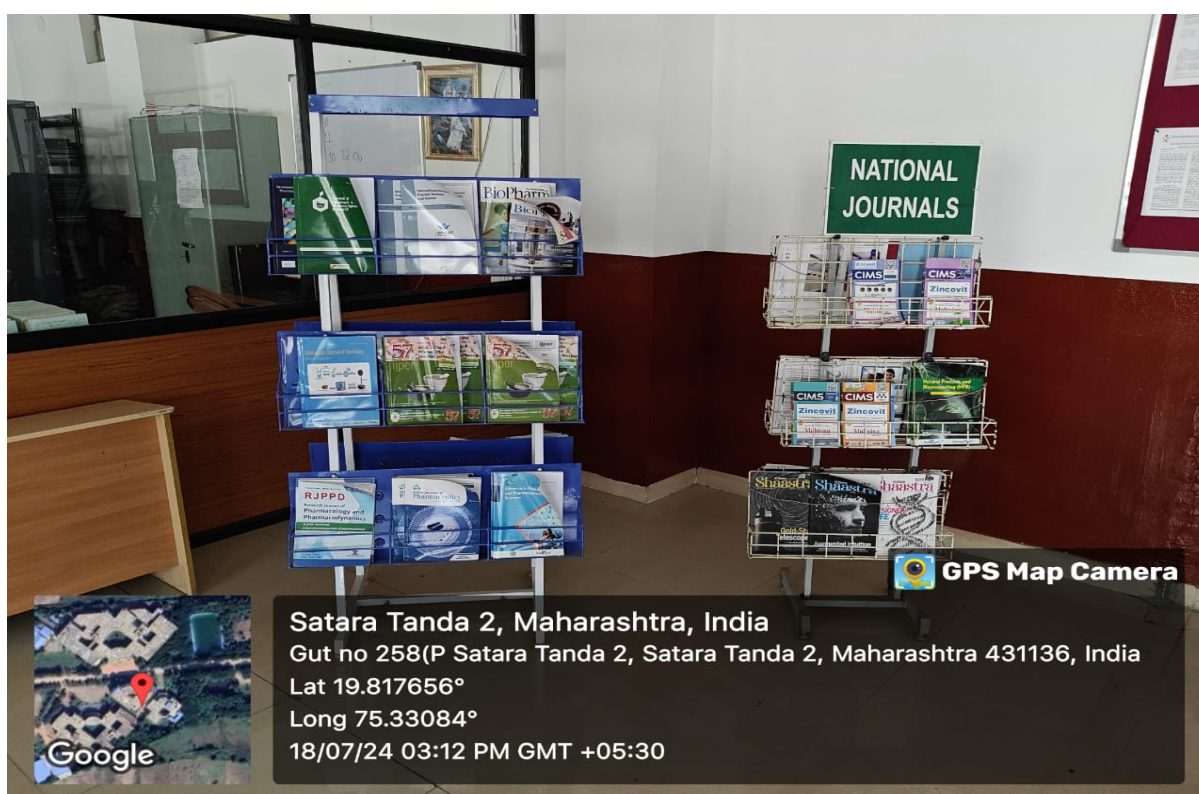




Figure 17: Library Internal view

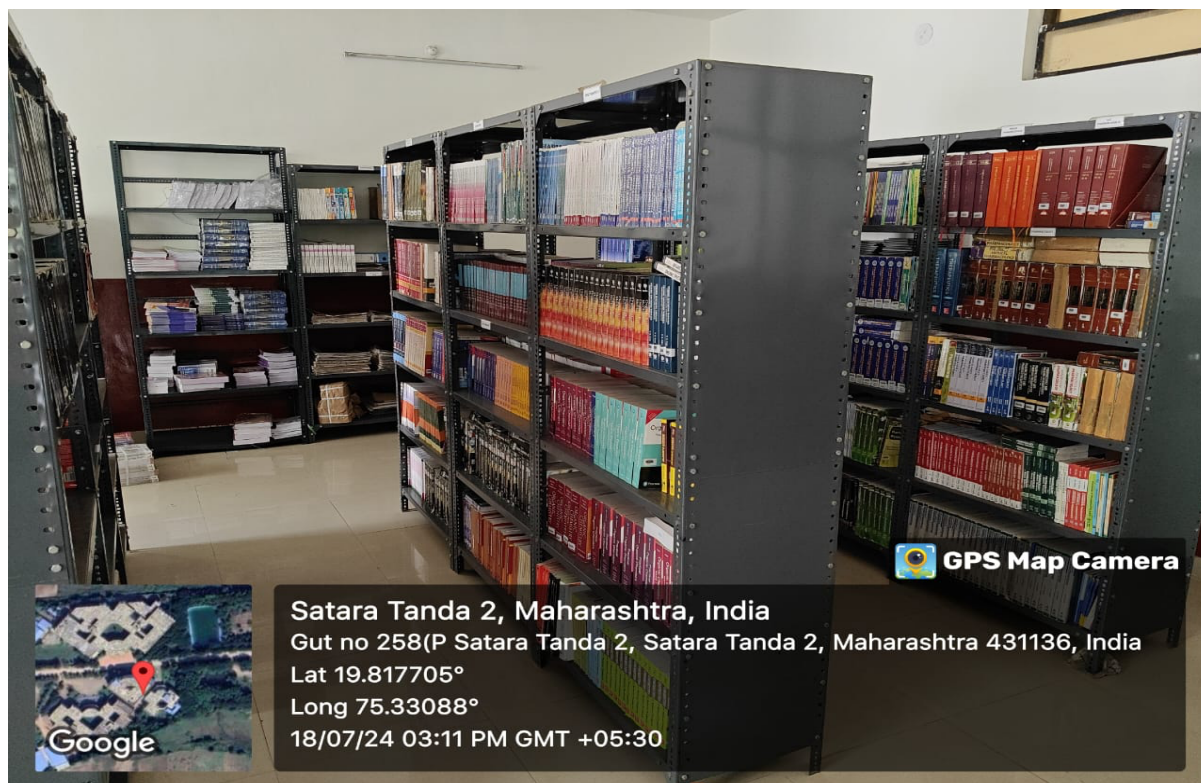
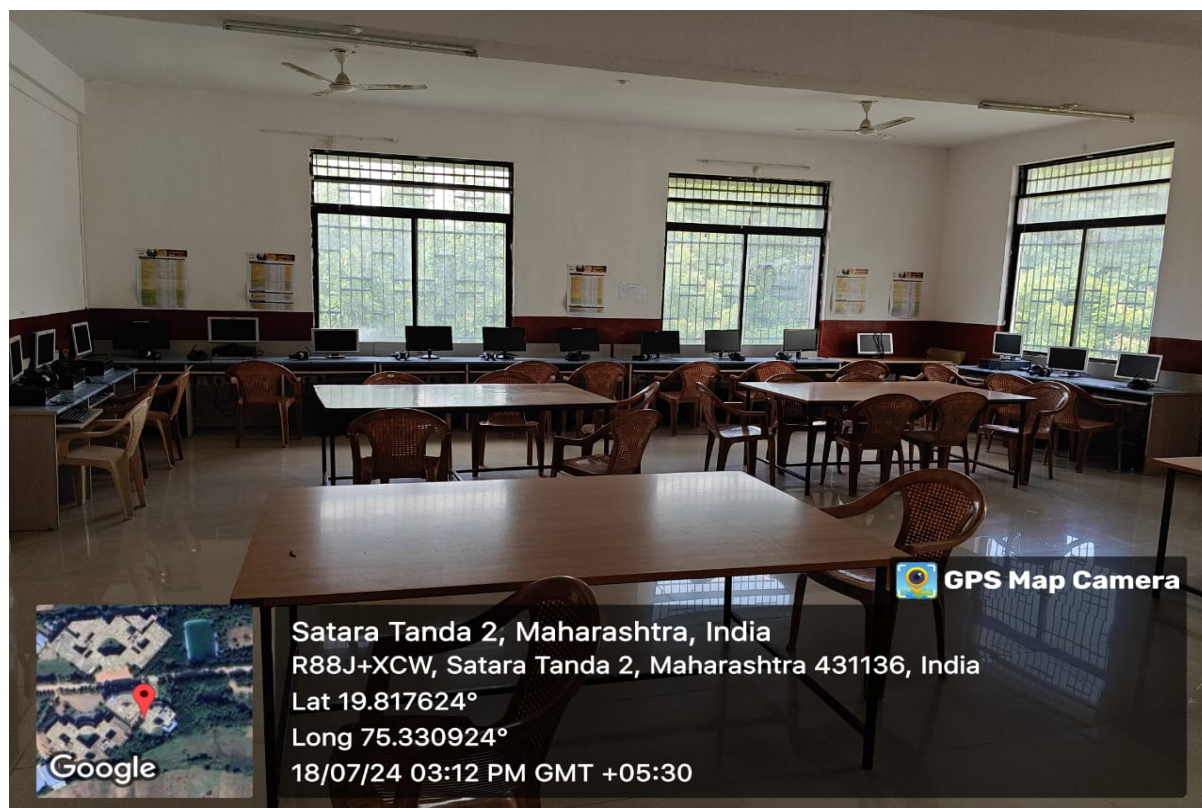


Figure 18 Digital Library
